

D-BLOCK HOOPS

Program Commitment & Outside Team Participation

At D-BLOCK HOOPS, we ask for a high level of commitment from every player and family involved in our program. In order to maintain strong commitment, team chemistry, accountability and consistent development, players may NOT participate on more than one basketball team during the D-BLOCK HOOPS season unless prior written approval is granted by the coaching staff.

(School sanctioned events are approved, however these conflicts will still need to be discussed with coaching staff.)

If an exception is approved, D-BLOCK HOOPS must remain the player's FIRST priority. This includes:

- Practices
- Games
- Tournaments
- Team events and scheduled activities. Keeping in mind that practice and game schedules may change. Parents and players must fully understand that full commitment be with their D-BLOCK Hoops team no matter the change in schedules.

Any outside basketball commitments must not conflict with D-BLOCK HOOPS practices or competitions. (School sanctioned events are approved, however these conflicts will still need to be discussed with coaching staff.)

Failure to meet this commitment and choosing any other basketball obligations will result in:

- Reduced playing time resulting in first incident- Player suspension for one day of the upcoming/following tournament. Second incident- Full suspension of the next upcoming/following tournament.
- Adjusted roles within the team. Players who choose other basketball obligations during D-BLOCK practices or games will not be eligible starting positions and or any leadership roles.

Our goal is to provide a competitive, organized, and development-focused environment for all athletes. This policy ensures fairness, accountability, and the best experience for the entire team. With this kind commitment it will help us ensure that we continue to build strong teams and strong players in the seasons to come.
